Putnam earns ACBL service award

Roger Putnam, one of ACBL's most popular tournament directors – with his peers as well as with players – has been named as the 2008 recipient of the Jane Johnson Award for



outstanding service.

The award is named in honor of the late head of ACBL's Member Services Department.

Earlier this year, Patty Taylor in Member Services and Dana Norton in Education received the Jane

Johnson Award given to Headquarters employees.

Putnam has many friends and admirers in the ACBL ranks.

"Roger is a very good role model as a floor TD," said Rick Beyre, ACBL's chief tournament director. "He knows how to talk to the players. When I first started out, I liked the way he worked and I wanted to be like him. When I worked on his team I always learned something."

Putnam, who lives in Redmond WA near Seattle, worked his first tournament in 1967 and has plied his trade at NABCs three times a year since 1969. He achieved national rank as a TD in 1985.

"You have to be very lucky for your avocation to turn into your vocation," he said, noting that he is going on part-time status as of the first of next month. He and his wife, Margo, a former TD herself, plan to play more bridge and do some traveling.

"I have always enjoyed playing and the challenge of the game," Putnam said.

National TD Patty Johnson remembers the help she received from Putnam when she first started as a TD. "He was one of those who wanted to help you make it," she said. "He was always more interested in others than in himself."

Matt Smith, of Victoria BC, has worked many tournaments with Putnam because they live in the Northwest. "Roger is always up and helpful to people – and he has always been that way," Smith said.

Putnam said that his going on part-time status doesn't mean NABC regulars have seen the last of him. He might still work at the big tournaments, or "I may show up to play."

California Institute of Technology won the Collegiate Team Championship. Team members are Cheng William Hong, Hsi-Chun Liu, Roger Lee and Chien-Yao Tseng.



Cal Tech takes Collegiate Championship

Twenty-eight teams began play online last February and now there is one. California Institute of Technology is the 2008 Collegiate Champion.

The top eight teams from the online qualification round played here in a round robin. Harvard advanced to play Princeton, and Michigan played Cal Tech. Princeton and Cal Tech won their matches and played in the final in which Cal Tech won by a score of 144–25.

For the winning team, Roger Lee is a senior who is math and economics major; Chien Yao is a physics A major from Taiwan; Hsi-Chun Liu is an electrical engineering major from Taiwan; and Cheng William Hong is a computer science major from Singapore.

The second-place Princeton team was Peter Diao, Nathan Savir, Jonathan Ullman and James Sundstrom.

GNTs now in semifinals

Four flights of the Grand National Teams are down to the round of four as teams that began at the grass roots level strive for national championships.

Competitors are doing battle in the Championship Flight, plus Flights A, B and C. The event will conclude on Sunday.

In the top flight, last year's winners – Mike Becker, Warren Spector, Jeff Meckstroth, Eric Rodwell, David Berkowitz and Larry Cohen – are still playing.

The defending champs, from District 9, trailed at the halfway point of their match with the District 12 squad captained by Perry Johnson. The Becker team took the lead after three quarters and won the match 99-81 to advance to the final against District 16.

English-Irish duo lead LM Pairs

Tom Hanlon of Ireland and Paul Hackett of England hold a narrow lead heading into the semifinal round of the Von Zedtwitz Life Master Pairs today.

Their carryover score of 1302.96 was just ahead of the 1292.14 posted by Walt and Kathie Walvick of McLean VA.

In the Bruce LM-5000 Life Master Pairs, the leaders, also by a narrow margin, are Bill McKenna of Darien IL and Frank Pancoe of Glen Ellyn IL, just ahead of Roger Snowling of Hamilton ON and Gary Westfall of Brampton ON.

In the Young LM-1500 Life Master Pairs, James Wang of Tempe AZ and Min Xu of Oxnard CA were in first after two qualifying sessions, followed by Charles Riffle of Emerald Hills CA and J Beck of Millbrae CA.



They won the Junior Team Trials in Las Vegas earlier this week and will represent the U.S. in the Patino Cup (for players 26 and younger) in Beijing, China, this fall: Eric Mayefsky, Stanford CA; Victor Chubukov, San Francisco; Roger Lee, Arcadia CA, and Kevin Fay, Ann Arbor MI.

ACBL bans electronic devices in national events

The ACBL Board of Directors approved a comprehensive ban on electronic devices for all national level events, but not to regional or Intermediate Newcomer contests:

Electronic devices, excluding health related equipment, capable of sending or receiving communication, including but not limited to, headphones, earphones, cellular phones and minicomputers: (1) shall not be allowed in the playing areas, adjacent hallways, restrooms or accessible break areas; and (2) shall not be used during a session.

These restrictions shall apply to all pairs, team members, captains, coaches, recorders and kibitzers and shall apply throughout any actual playing session or segment.

A violation of this policy shall result in a disciplinary penalty of one full board (or 12 IMPs at that form of scoring) for the first offense. A second offense shall result in disqualification from the event for the pair/team.

Kibitzers violating this policy shall be removed from the playing area for the remainder of the session.

The Summer North American Bridge Championships in Las Vegas will be the first NABC impacted by the new policy.

Participants in the following contests will be reminded not to approach the playing area with a personal electronic device in their possession, even if the device is turned off: all flights of the Grand National Teams, the von Zedtwitz, Bruce and Young Life Master Pairs, the Spingold Knockout Teams, both Mini-Spingolds, the Wagar Women's Knockout Teams, the Truscott/USPC Senior Swiss Teams, the Wernher Open Pairs, the NABC+ Fast Pairs, the Mixed Board-a-Match Teams, the Open Swiss Teams and the National 199er Pairs.

JUST FOR NEW PLAYERS

Dear New Players:

Today I'm going to tell you the True Story of how I tried my level best to get arrested at the Canadian border.



This was the year the NABC was held in Toronto. What a great tournament! Great bridge, great food, great shopping. I was traveling with my friend, Tenna, and we had an especially good vacation, but alas, it was time to leave.

You can tell how long we've been away from home by how much stuff is in the back seat of our car. We don't believe in littering, so all trash is tossed into the back seat. We had our special pillows and a couple lap robes back there, as well as assorted carry-ons, plunder from various shops, maps we couldn't get back into their original folds, emergency food rations, bottles of water.

We were crossing back into the States at Niagara Falls, and there was a long wait to get through border crossing. At first, we didn't mind, as the people-watching and activity level made it interesting. Eventually though, we got bored and wanted some action. And we got it.

The car in front of us reached the guard station. Something about it must have interested the guards, because they were tearing the car apart – dogs sniffing, stuff being taken out of the car, mirrors searching underneath. Wow – action.

Why, just that morning I had gotten my poor partner into a 6NT contract, off two aces, thanks to my confusion about whether we play Roman Key Card Blackwood 1430 or 0314. She made it, too.

She had all the tricks except the two major-suit aces. Neither opponent had doubled, so she knew the aces were split. Break number one, LHO didn't lead her ace. My partner took the first trick and led up to my seven-card heart suit on the board, topped with K-J-10-9, etc. Break number two, RHO did some counting and realized she needed to hold up on her heart ace once. There were no other entries to my wretched hand and she didn't want my partner to be able to run the suit.

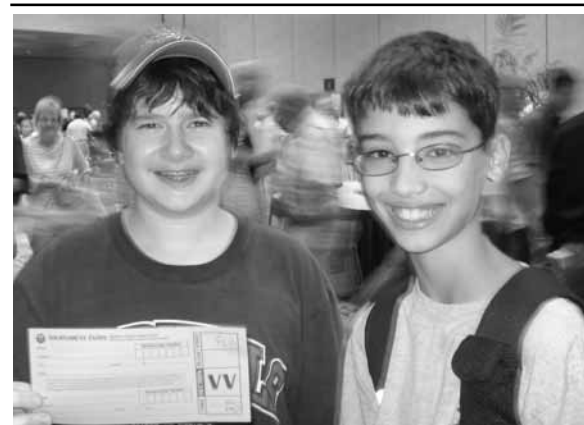
On that first heart trick, LHO revoked! Break number three! She played a low spade. My partner realized that if LHO had the spade ace, she could make her contract. Pard had the ♠K Q doubleton. LHO indeed had the ♠A, pard made one good,

never played hearts or spades again and made seven.

Boring? Ha!

Opening lead: ♦Q.

Bidding commentary: As North, your 2♥ response is natural and positive. Some play a positive response guarantees two of the top three honors, a bit restrictive. Agreeing the trump suit at the three level (3♠) facilitates slam bidding. Also, two aces plus the queen of partner's suit facing any sane 2♣ opening should be more than enough for slam. 4NT was Roman Keycard

Blackwood (RKB) and the 5♠ response shows two keycards (the four aces and the trump king are key cards) plus the ♠Q. A 5♥ response also shows two key cards but denies the ♠Q. As South, though you can only count 12 sure tricks, heart establishment plus at worst the club finesse make bidding a grand slam odds on.

Play commentary: As South, in order to avoid the club finesse, you must try to set up at least one of dummy's hearts for a club discard. When setting up a long suit in dummy, keep as many late entries to dummy as possible. Win the ♦K and play the ♠A and ♠K, East discarding a club or a diamond. Notice that the ♦A and the

♠Q remain as "late" dummy entries. Next, cash the ♥K and play a heart to the ace, ruffing a heart with the ♠J in case West is out of hearts. He is! There is still one higher heart outstanding (you are counting hearts, of course). Not to worry, you have two dummy entries. Cross to the ♠Q, drawing West's last trump and ruff a heart. Don't look now, but you have established dummy's fifth heart for your 13th trick! Cross to the ♦A and discard the ♣J on the long heart. Well done.

When setting up a long suit, use trump entries before side-suit entries (♠Q before ♦A).

Poker players gamble on slam

Steve Zolotow and Phil Gordon are famous poker players who are also good bridge players. The number 13 is considered unlucky by some gamblers, but not these two. They bid slam on board 13 in the first qualifying session of the Von Zedtwitz Life Master Pairs. The hands are rotated.

Gordon cuebid 3♣ to show a limit raise or better. Players who instead jumped to 4♥, preempted their partner. Over East's 3♠ bid, Zolotow jumped directly to 6♥. He didn't want to cuebid, reasoning that doing so would likely help the opponents with their opening lead.

Zolotow ruffed the ♣Q opening lead and drew trumps. The contract was secure, but how to make an overtrick? Declarer went to the board with the ♦K and led another, finessing the jack. This was a no-risk play; if the finesse lost, he could discard a spade loser from the board on his ♦A and still make six.

Bidding six and making seven was worth 19.5 matchpoints. Bidding and making only six scored 13.5

Just like Zia

Steve Nellison of Ramsey NJ was impressed with his partner's initial shot on this deal from the Grand National Teams, Flight A. "It was a Zia lead," said Nellison of the trick-one play by Victor Hsu of Waldwick NJ.

Hsu listened to the bidding and selected the ♠K for his opening shot. Declarer could still have made the contract after ruffing a couple of diamonds in dummy and pulling trumps if he had played spade to dummy's 9, but the lead of the ♠K gave declarer the impression that Hsu had started with the ♠Q as well.

The job for the defense was not done even when Nellison took the ♠J with the queen, however. A spade or diamond return would have subjected Hsu to a major-suit squeeze. Nellison was up to the task, switching to his singleton heart to break up the squeeze and earn his side a useful swing.

GNT: Flights B and C

Qualifications for teams participating in the Grand National Teams Flights B and C were earned in local-level events earlier this year.

Flight B winners will have their names engraved on the Sheinwold Trophy while the names of Flight C winners will be engraved on the Mac Nab Trophy.

Alfred Sheinwold

Alfred Sheinwold (1912-1997) was one of the greatest bridge writers in the history of the game. He was inducted into the Bridge Hall of Fame in 1996.

His syndicated bridge column was considered by many to be the best — he had a knack for getting his point across to even the least experienced players. He managed this by making sure that every column had only one main point, marking it easier for his readers to focus.

"You could read a Sheinwold column and know in an instant that nobody else could have written it," said Frank Stewart, co-author of the column. "He enlightened and entertained players through seven decades and earned millions of fans."

Sheinwold was an editor of *The Bridge World* from 1934 to 1963 and editor of *The Bridge Bulletin* from 1953 to 1958. He was also the author of perhaps the most successful bridge book ever written, *5 Weeks to Winning Bridge*, a book that sold in the millions.

Sheinwold served as chairman of the ACBL Laws Commission from 1964 to 1975, as chairman of the appeals committees at NABCs and as chairman of the ACBL Board of Governors from 1970 to 1973. He was named ACBL *Honorary Member of the Year* in 1983.

Robin Mac Nab

Robin Mac Nab (1915-1985) served as a member of the ACBL Board of Directors from 1956 to 1981. He was ACBL president in 1965. He was a past president of the Western Conference, a member of the ACBL Laws Commission and a member of the executive council of the World Bridge Federation.

Mac Nab, a graduate of Cornell University, was a member of the U.S. Olympic track and field squad in 1936.

Pearls before swine?

We won't name the East and West players, but here is a tale of woe. You hold, as East,

♠ J 4
♥ K 3
♦ 10 9 5
♣ A K 10 8 4 2

This is the auction

West	North	East	South

Assuming partner is sane, you can give him ♠A K Q x x x, the ♦A (he could not risk the five level without it) and one more card. If you had just a little more in clubs, you could bid 6NT. As it is, do you pass or bid slam?

Neither option is correct. The right call is 5NT, improving the contract but denying the ability to

bid slam. Partner will bid on with the ♣Q (or perhaps the ♦Q) and/or an eighth spade, right?

Wrong! Partner re-corrects 5NT to 6♠, down a trick, and that turns 25 out of 25 matchpoints to .5 MPs. The full deal:

Yes, on a diamond lead 5NT looks precarious, but if you duck a diamond and South does not switch to a club, you can run seven rounds of spades and make plus 490 on a triple squeeze.

At one point in the opponents' auction, Zia made a psychic double of a call by Sharif, leading the Egyptian to take the wrong line of play. The result was that Sharif went down in a contract he would have made without Zia's double.

Said Zia of his friend Sharif: "He didn't speak to me for two years after that."

Back to the LM Pairs.

On this deal, Zia made a bid many players would not find to earn his side another good score.

Cohler's feather-light takeout double prompted Zia to make the creative bid of 2♠ on his three-card suit, encouraging Cohler to make what would turn out to be the best opening lead for his side.

As you can see, the lead of a club or a diamond lead makes declarer's task easy. Although West can always take nine tricks if he can see all the cards, the spade lead from Cohler got the defense off to the best start. Declarer ducked to Zia's queen, won the spade continuation with the ace, then played a club to his king. West returned to dummy with a heart to lead another club. Zia won the ♣A perforce, put Cohler in with a third round of spades, then took a club ruff, getting out of his hand with the ♦9. Declarer had no choice but to finesse, so he finished one down. Plus 100 was good for 19.5 out of 25 matchpoints for Zia and Cohler.

So, how does declarer make nine tricks even after a spade lead? He wins the ♠A, plays a club from dummy, winning the king if South ducks. Declarer then plays to the ♥K, cashes the queen and takes the marked trump finesse. If South covers, West pulls the last trump and plays a low club from hand. If South does not cover the ♥10, declarer plays a diamond to the ace, cashes the ♥A and plays a low club from hand. It's easy when you can see all the cards.

When declarer misguessed clubs, he was minus 500, more than the value of the East-West game if it had been making.

On the next round, Leong was back on the hot seat.

At our table, we stopped in 2♠, which was a good idea because West, Dick Hanna, led his singleton club. Declarer won in dummy to run the ♠J. Dick now prevented his partner from error by immediately underleading the ♥A. If he had cashed the ace before leading a heart to the king, partner might shift to a diamond.

The underlead left Larry Hanna on lead, and he knew what to do. A club return left declarer needing to take the spade finesse to get back to plus 140.

Monitoring

At this and future North American Championships, ACBL will be monitoring NABC+ events with visible, real-time cameras. The images will be recorded and will be available for later official inspection and review.

By general monitoring of the session and participants' behavior, ACBL has another source of information that may be useful in determining facts and settling issues arising from some types of ethical and behavioral complaints or actions. Please summon a director if a problem occurs at the table.

This procedure is intended to assure everyone that the playing field is level and that misbehavior will not be tolerated.

Bid Box Alerts and Announcements

When using bid boxes, ACBL suggests that players tap the Alert strip and say "Alert" at the same time.

When making an announcement, use the announcement word — such as "transfer" — and tap the Alert strip at the same time.

A player who Alerts or announces a bid should make sure his opponents are aware that an Alert or announcement has been made.

**Pre-Alert/
Disclosure forms**

If your partnership plays special overcalls, you must fill out a pre-Alert/Disclosure form and make it available to your opponents when you play in events that allow Mid-Chart and Super-Chart conventions.

This applies to NABC+, regional or higher knockout and Flight A Swiss games. Look for the light blue forms on the table where convention cards are available.

Las Vegas 2001: A look back

The Las Vegas tournaments are heavily attended. The city holds the record for both Summer and Fall NABC attendance.

The highest count for a Fall NABC (and the fifth largest ever) was Las Vegas in 2001 with 16,818 tables in play. The 1973 tournament was the fifth largest fall tournament.

The Summer Las Vegas tournaments, however, are the blockbusters. The all-time record for an NABC is 24,221 tables held here in 1991. The third largest and fourth largest also took place here (1985 with 19,827.5 and 1979 with 18,517.5). Any bets on this year's attendance setting another record?

West leads the ♠9. East overtakes with the 10 and you ruff. Everyone follows to the ♦A. Now what? Decide before reading on.

Here's Kantar's answer:

Enter dummy with a club and lead a diamond to the ♦J. If the finesse wins, the most you can possibly lose is two heart tricks. If the finesse loses, you will be able to discard dummy's hearts on your clubs and ruff a heart in dummy.

The only way to lose the deal is to play off two top trumps and then start clubs. East ruffs early and plays a heart, a most unhappy ending for you.

Convention card reminder

Each player is required to have a convention card filled out legibly and on the table throughout a session. Both cards of a partnership must be identical and include the first and last names of each member of the partnership.

If a director determines that neither player has a substantially completed card, the partnership may play only the ACBL Yellow Card and may use only standard carding. This restriction may be lifted only at the beginning of a subsequent round after convention cards have been properly prepared and approved by the director. Further, the partnership will receive a 1/6-board matchpoint penalty for each board played, commencing with the next round and continuing until the restriction is lifted.

If the director determines the partnership has at least one substantially completed convention card but has not fully complied with ACBL regulations, the director may give warnings or assign such penalties as he deems to be appropriate under the circumstances.
