PARKING

Monday-Friday

Please park in the visitor parking area in Lot 23, located off of Elm Drive, and take the shuttle (Central Line) up to Clio Hall.

Weekends

Visitors may park in any numbered lot. **The shuttle does not run during the weekend.**

TOURS AND INFORMATION SESSIONS

During the Academic Year

(early September-late June)

Monday-Friday

Tours and information sessions begin at Clio Hall.

Weekends

Tours begin at Frist Campus Center.*

During the Summer

(July 5-August 26)

Monday-Friday

Tours and information sessions begin at Frist Campus Center.

Weekends

Tours begin at the rotunda in Chancellor Green.

*During September and up to the Thanksgiving holiday, Saturday information sessions begin at Frist Campus Center.

DIRECTIONS TO AND FROM THE UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION OFFICE LOBBY IN CLIO HALL AND THE FRIST CAMPUS CENTER

Undergraduate Admission Office lobby in Clio Hall to Frist Campus Center:

Exit the front of Clio Hall, turn right, then right again alongside the building. Proceed down the steps, between the tigers, and turn left onto McCosh Walk. After passing the School of Architecture, turn right onto the walkway and proceed straight. You will pass the Woolworth Building on your right. Directly ahead will be Frist Campus Center. During the academic year, weekend tours leave from the Welcome Desk on the 100 level of Frist. *Please note: The accessible entrance to Clio Hall is located at the rear of Clio Hall on McCosh Walk. If you leave by this door, turn left and proceed down McCosh Walk past the School of Architecture.*

Frist Campus Center to the Clio Hall Undergraduate Admission Office lobby:

Exit Frist Campus Center on the north side (main entrance). Go straight and follow the walkway past the Woolworth Building on your left. Turn left at the corner past the School of Architecture building and proceed onto McCosh Walk. Continue on McCosh Walk, taking the stairs on your right between Whig and Clio Halls. Turn left and walk up the Clio Hall steps to the entrance. The Undergraduate Admission Office lobby is located on the second floor. *Please note: The accessible entrance to Clio Hall is located at the rear of Clio Hall on McCosh Walk. Once on McCosh Walk, continue past the Art Museum until you see Whig and Clio halls on your right.*

DIRECTIONS TO AND FROM THE UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION OFFICE LOBBY IN CLIO HALL AND THE ENGINEERING QUADRANGLE (E-QUAD)

Undergraduate Admission Office lobby in Clio Hall to E-Quad:

Exit the front of Clio Hall, turn right, then right again alongside the building. Proceed down the steps and turn left onto McCosh Walk. Continue straight until you reach the pedestrian crossing at Washington Road. After crossing Washington Road, continue straight on the walkway, to the left of the Woodrow Wilson School fountain. Frick Lab will be on your left. Continue on the path, crossing Charlton Street, until you reach the crossing at Olden Street. The Engineering Quad will be directly across the street. *Please note: The accessible entrance to Clio Hall is located at the rear of Clio Hall on McCosh Walk. If you leave by this door, turn left and proceed down McCosh Walk.*

E-Quad to the Clio Hall Undergraduate Admission Office lobby:

Exit the E-Quad on the west side (main entrance). Cross Olden Street and continue straight on the walkway to the left of the Computer Science building. Cross Charlton Street and continue on past the Woodrow Wilson School fountain on your left. Cross Washington Road then continue straight on McCosh Walk, taking the stairs on your right between Whig and Clio Halls. Turn left and walk up the Clio Hall steps to the entrance. The Undergraduate Admission Office lobby is located on the second floor. *Please note: The accessible entrance to Clio Hall is located at the rear of Clio Hall on*

McCosh Walk. Once on McCosh Walk, continue past the Art Museum until you see Whig and Clio halls on your right.
