



Fall Early Arrival Approval Process

Policies

- All early arrivals (prior to September 12) must be pre-approved
- Program/Department Heads sponsoring official University pre-orientation and orientation programs must request approval for their entire group through an online application process and are responsible for notifying participants of approved arrival date.
- Students who are not part of a group, and supporting an official University pre-orientation or orientation program, must request approval for early arrival through an online process.

- All students returning to campus prior to September 12 need written confirmation before committing funds or organizing activities.
- Pre-approved groups/individuals arriving prior to September 1st will live in assigned housing.
- Pre-approved groups/individuals may move into their regular year room on September 1.
- Prox cards will be activated on the approved date of arrival.
- Early arrival housing contracts for program sponsors and students will reflect responsibilities associated with campus housing before September 12.
- The Early Arrival Policy Committee (EAPC) will review each request.
