



SIGN-IN INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW MAJORS

Students planning to enter the Chemistry Department must follow the procedure shown below. Prospective majors are strongly encouraged to attend the Department's Open House held during March of the Spring Term.

Step 1 – Information Session

Each student is required to complete an information session with the Department's Undergraduate Administrator. This one-on-one meeting will cover:

- Course requirements
- The Junior and Senior Independent Work programs
- Opportunities for Study Abroad experiences
- Preparation for graduate school, if applicable
- The Chemistry Outreach Program
- Science-related certificates

Students also have the opportunity to ask questions, discuss how their extracurricular activities fit into the demands of the program, and other issues of concern.
