### Budget Form

In preparing your budget, please bear in mind that housing in Princeton is limited and expensive. The Nassau Inn (\$149 and up) and the Peacock Inn (\$180 and up) are within walking distance of the library. Outlying motels, which may have shuttles or nearby bus stops, have rates averaging over \$100.

The Princeton University Housing Department maintains a [listing of off-campus apartment](#) rentals.

A shuttle train links the campus directly to Princeton Junction, which is a stop for numerous daily New Jersey Transit trains and some Amtrak trains; hence, applicants can also pursue other, less-local housing arrangements.
