## Dear Residents,

On behalf of the Butler committee I would like to wish you a great year and take some time to describe what we do.



The Butler Committee is made up of residents – students and spouses/partners living at Butler who meet once a month to work on issues affecting the quality of life for our residents. The committee tends to be representative of a the wide variety of Butler residents. We have a small budget, mainly for social activities. We maintain a dolly for moving in and out, and reservation of the community room for private parties. There is a garden area for residents who wish to have small gardening plots. The committee works closely with the administration and other university groups such as the GSG. We have a list of major maintenance requests that we submit every fall. We hope to see storage units around Butler as a result of last year's requests. Butler Committee representatives serve on various policy groups within the university, such as the Housing Draw group, the Shuttle group and other committees.

One project that is of particular ongoing importance to us is insulation. Many of our units are older and do not hold heat very well, and the heating units are not always very efficient at distributing heat within the apartment. During the last year, the average heating bill for a winter month was about \$130, and we are pursuing having insulation added to unrenovated units. In general, we are committed finding creative solutions for improving the physical condition of the units in general, and would love feedback.

We usually meet on the first Tuesday of every month at 9:30. Come visit, learn about how the university is run and voice your opinion. Everyone is welcome.

Again, welcome to Butler apartments and the start of a new school year.

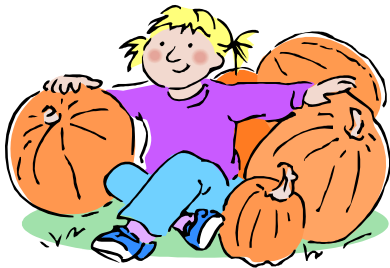




# Children's Fall Festival

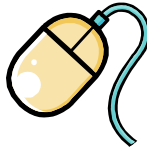

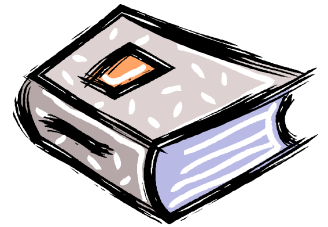

**Dollies and ladders** are available for you to borrow in Butler!



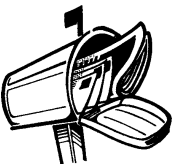

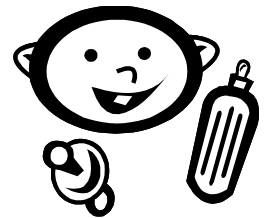
