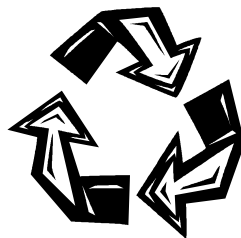

New positions will be open on the Butler committee this year.

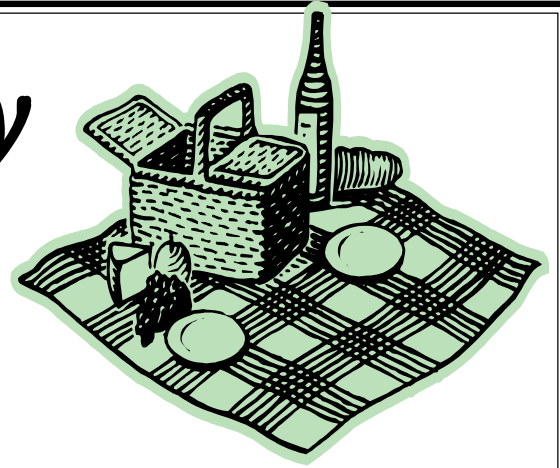
In order to join the Butler Committee you must attend at least three committee meetings.

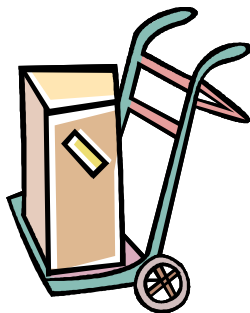

When Posting, please remember to include the type of animals, what is needed for care, the dates, your address (because proximity is key for convenience) and your contact information. An interested sitter should then contact the requesting party directly.

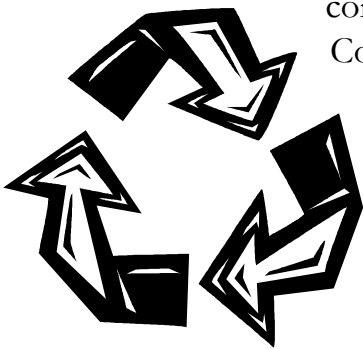
It's Gardening Time!

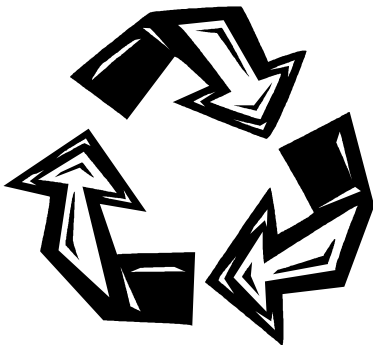
Recycling in Butler

Commingled mixed paper

Brown paper bags, cardboard, colored paper, posters, envelopes, magazines, newspaper, paper back books, phone books

Glass, metal & plastic - please clean and rinse first!

Glass bottles & jars, aluminum, steel & tin cans, yogurt containers, plastic soda & water bottles, milk & juice Containers of all kinds, detergent Bottles



Trash - the following are not recyclable!

Plastic bags, cigarettes, food, glassware, light bulbs, napkins, **pizza boxes**, paper & plastic utensils, silverware, styrofoam, tin foil, tissues, toys, waxed paper
