



RECYCLING AT PRINCETON UNIVERSITY



Did you know that there have been a lot of changes made at Princeton University over the past few years regarding what is recyclable in offices and residences? The following are guidelines for recycling:



COMMINGLED MIXED PAPER



The following items can be placed in the black containers marked “**Recycle Paper Only**”:

| Envelopes (All) | Fax Paper | Index Cards | Kraft paper |
| Magazines | Manila Envelopes | NCR Forms | Newspaper |
| Pads & Forms | Pamphlets | Paper Back Books | Paper Board** |
| Phone Books | Post Its | Posters | |

* Cardboard boxes should be broken down and flattened .

** Paper board, also known as box board, is material used for packaging of cookies, crackers, cereal, etc. Please remove inner cellophane or waxed paper liners



GLASS, ALUMINUM & PLASTIC



The following items should be placed in the nearest receptacle marked for “**Bottles and Cans**”:

| Glass Bottles and Jars | Aluminum, Steel and Tin Cans | Milk Containers |
| Juice Containers | Plastic Soda and Water Bottles | Yogurt Containers |
| Detergent and Softener Bottles | Soda Cans and Bottles | Paper Juice Containers |

Rinse containers and remove all lids!



TRASH



The following items are considered trash and should not be placed in any container intended for recycling:

| Tin Foil | Tissues | Toys | Waxed Paper |
