In 1984, a **deadly gas leak** in a Union Carbide factory in Bhopal caused one of the worst industrial disasters of modern times. **8,000 people died immediately**; thousands more died subsequently, and others continue to suffer. The accident has had a **devastating environmental impact**. The health and environmental problems are aggravated by **continuing negligence**.

The past 19 years have seen a **unique global movement for justice in Bhopal**. **H. Rajan Sharma**, an attorney representing the Bhopal gas tragedy survivors in U.S. Federal Court, will talk about the movement and present a documentary entitled "The Betrayal of Bhopal."
