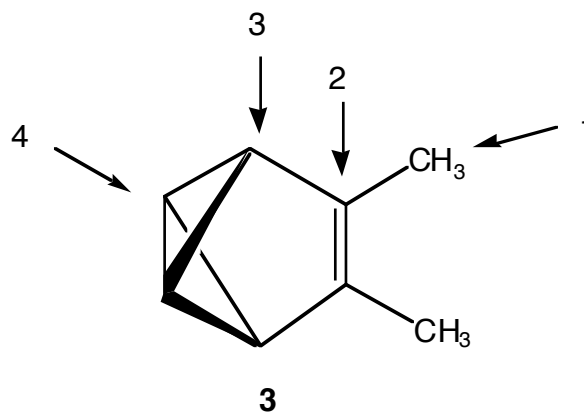
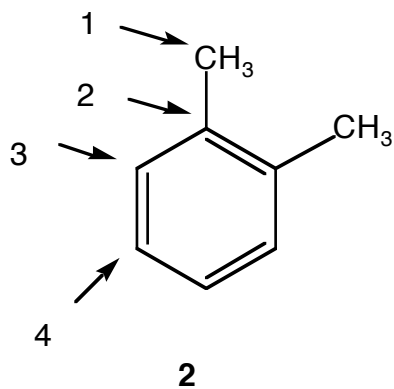
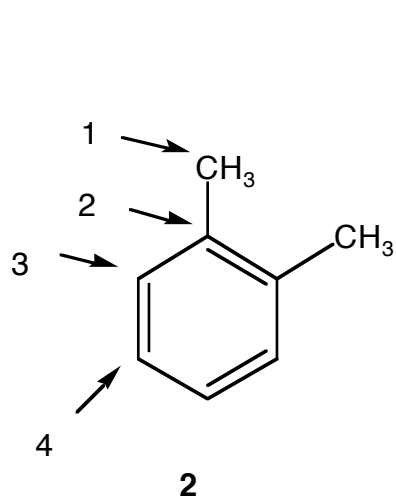


Answers to Problem 20, Chemistry 301X - 2006
