7) 出席 / 授業態度

Attending class everyday is mandatory. Every time you miss a class you will lose 0.5% out of 5% from your attendance grade. For every three times you come to class late in excess of 10 minutes (but no more than 20 min.), your late attendance is counted as one absence. If you will be late or cannot come to a class with a legitimate reason (e.g. illness, etc.), please contact your instructor by e-mail or phone before class starts.

You are expected not only to be present, but also to actively participate in class.

9) 小テスト/レクソンテスト

Quizzes and tests will be given **at the beginning of the class period.**

To receive full credit, you may arrange to take a quiz or test in advance **if you have a legitimate reason**. Missed quizzes or tests must be made up within two days of the class. Without a legitimate excuse, 20% will be deducted from your score.

10) 日直<sup>にちちよく</sup> (朝のスピーチ)

Each day, at the beginning of the first class of the day, 日直 delivers a weather forecast, reports some brief news of the day, and presents a short story. The entire presentation should not exceed three minutes. For the short story, you may offer your impression of Kanazawa, relate an interesting anecdote from your host family experience, etc.

1 1 ) **Language Pledge**

You are required to use Japanese as your only language of communication in the facility (Rifare Building) and during extra-curricular activities. If you breach the language pledge three times, you will lose 3 points from your final grade.

1 2 ) **Japanese Language Table**

While attending the Japanese Language Table is NOT a requirement for JPN 105/JPN 107, it offers a chance for students to use their Japanese in a relaxed setting and to improve listening and speaking skills through casual conversation. Each time you participate in the Japanese Language Table, you will receive an extra 0.1 point. These extra points will be added to your final grade; however, extra points may not exceed 0.5 (0.1 points x 5).
