She is author and editor of numerous publications on the subject of risk regulation and has an international reputation for her work on compliance, regulatory enforcement, and business risk management. Her most recent books are "Anticipating Risks and Organising Risk Regulation" (editor, 2010), and "Organizational Encounters with Risk" (co-editor, 2005). She received her Ph.D. at the University of Oxford.
