

CLASS DAY CEREMONY

(Jadwin Gym in case of severe weather)

The Class Day ceremony is planned and presented by seniors. Although it varies from year to year, the event traditionally gives seniors an opportunity to acknowledge publicly achievements and contributions of members of the class and of the University community. The program includes the awarding of various prizes to classmates, dedication of the yearbook, presentation of the class gift to the University and of the “class history,” and remarks by President Shirley M. Tilghman. The event is ticketed and each senior receives four tickets for guests. The Class Day ceremony will be simulcast in **McCosh 10 (Wood Auditorium)** and **McCosh 50 (Helm Auditorium)**. No ticket is needed for these sites; they are accessible by elevator, and have accessible restrooms. McCosh 50 is air conditioned. Note: Students line up for the ceremony at 10:00 a.m., between the Art Museum and Dod Hall. If the ceremony is in Jadwin Gym, students take their places in the bleachers on the main floor of the gym and do not process.

The Class Day speaker this year is Katie Couric “CBS Evening News” Anchor and Managing Editor.

Each student receives 4 guest tickets to Class Day. These tickets are given to the students in May during senior checkout along with other Commencement tickets.

On Monday afternoon, academic departments and programs host receptions and/or special programs for seniors and their guests. This is an opportunity for guests to meet members of the department, and during the reception, many departments present awards or recognize seniors who have done outstanding work. Refreshments are served.
