Note:

Department graduate courses are listed on the department web sit, *but* the dean of the college no longer permits undergraduates to enroll, except as auditors, in philosophy graduate courses. An undergraduate interesting in a graduate seminar must apply for a reading course that just happens to be meet at the same hours and to have the same readings as the graduate seminar, and the instructor must produce for the dean's approval a statement of the basis on which the undergraduate will be graded. The student needs to obtain the reading course application form from the dean's office , secure the instructor's signature on the form and agreement to produce a grading statement to satisfy the dean, and besides obtain the departmental representative's signature and the department chair's. Best to get started early on the process, therefore, if interested.
