The WFR course will be taught by Wilderness Medical Associates, a leader in wilderness first aid education. Instruction will focus on emergency care in a wilderness context: remote locations, severe environments and improvised gear.

The 70-hour advanced first aid course covers patient examination and assessment, wilderness rescue, anatomy, trauma care, environmental emergencies, splints, and backcountry medicine. There will be lectures and skills practice, simulated rescues, daily quizzes, and a final exam. Be prepared for awesome outdoor first aid simulations!

Successful completion includes a 3-year certification as both Wilderness First Responder and CPR provider.
